### **Final Project**

#### **Group Assignment**

Create a radio show that incorporates the following elements:

- Station ID tag with music and sound effects
- Introduction to the show
- News, traffic, and weather reports
- Commercial break (either a single 1 minute spot or two 30-second spots)
- Interview with the artist
- Original song by the artist

Each of these elements must include the various layers of content discussed in class. The overall length will vary from project to project, but will typically range from 10 to 15 minutes overall. In each segment, the roles of Producer, Engineer, and Talent must be exchanged between the members of the group (i.e. if you are the VO talent for the commercial, you should be either the producer or engineer for one of the other segments).

This must be submitted as a single CD-quality stereo .wav file. You will present this to your colleagues in class.

#### **Individual Assignment**

Keep a detailed log of your experience over the next few weeks as you work on this project. Take special note of whatever contributions you make, what problems you encounter and how you solve them (or how you are unable to solve them).

Answer the following questions in your essay:

How did you apply the knowledge you gained in this class?

What knowledge/information proved helpful (if any)?

Which aspects of this project were the most challenging? How did you deal with/overcome these?

Use this log to write a detailed paper about the project, your contributions to it, and what you learned from the experience. Length may vary a bit, but typically these papers would be expected to run at least 2-3 pages.

For extra credit, hand in any additional written work that was necessary for this project: scripts, song lyrics, etc.
